General comments	Germany welcomes the sound analysis and programme design which highlights the significant strives being made by the government of Benin to advance issues raised, but also highlights and addresses continuous challenges.	
	It is particularly welcome that UNICEF puts a clear regional focus	
	(p. 5) on the North and on situations of emergency. Data show	
	that the Northern region are particularly affected by	
	problems such as stunting. This is the region which is also	
	affected by the spillover of insecurity.	
	The strategic priorities and concrete outcome indicators are well	
	chosen, results-oriented and clearly defined. They aim at	
	improving (a) equitable access to quality health, nutrition and	
	water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH), b) facilitating access to	
	quality and inclusive education (c) creating an enabling, inclusive	

	and safe environment d) strengthening resilience of the social protection system.
Comments on specific aspects of the draft country programme documents	 A stronger focus on the strengthening of sexual and reproductive rights of women and girls would have been welcome, in synergy with the UNFPA country programme. We have suggested that the UNFPA programme could be better aligned to the UNICEF country programme which clearly has a focus on the 4 Northern departments.
