- Global agreements and initiatives with United Nations agencies in health, protection, WASH, social policy, gender, mental health, financing for development and youth engagement.
- Engagement across five pillars of the United Nations development system UN framework for the immediate socio-economic response to COVID-19; social protection co-lead with WFP.
- Engagement with WHO and others in the ACT-Accelerator almost 72 million
   COVID-19 vaccines shipped to 126 countries through COVAX.
