Economic growth

has **stagnated** since 2011

Real GDP is expected to have **fallen by 10.4%** in 2020.

Overweight in children under the age of 5 years is among the highest rate in the region.

Adolescents complete their secondary education.

4 **60%**

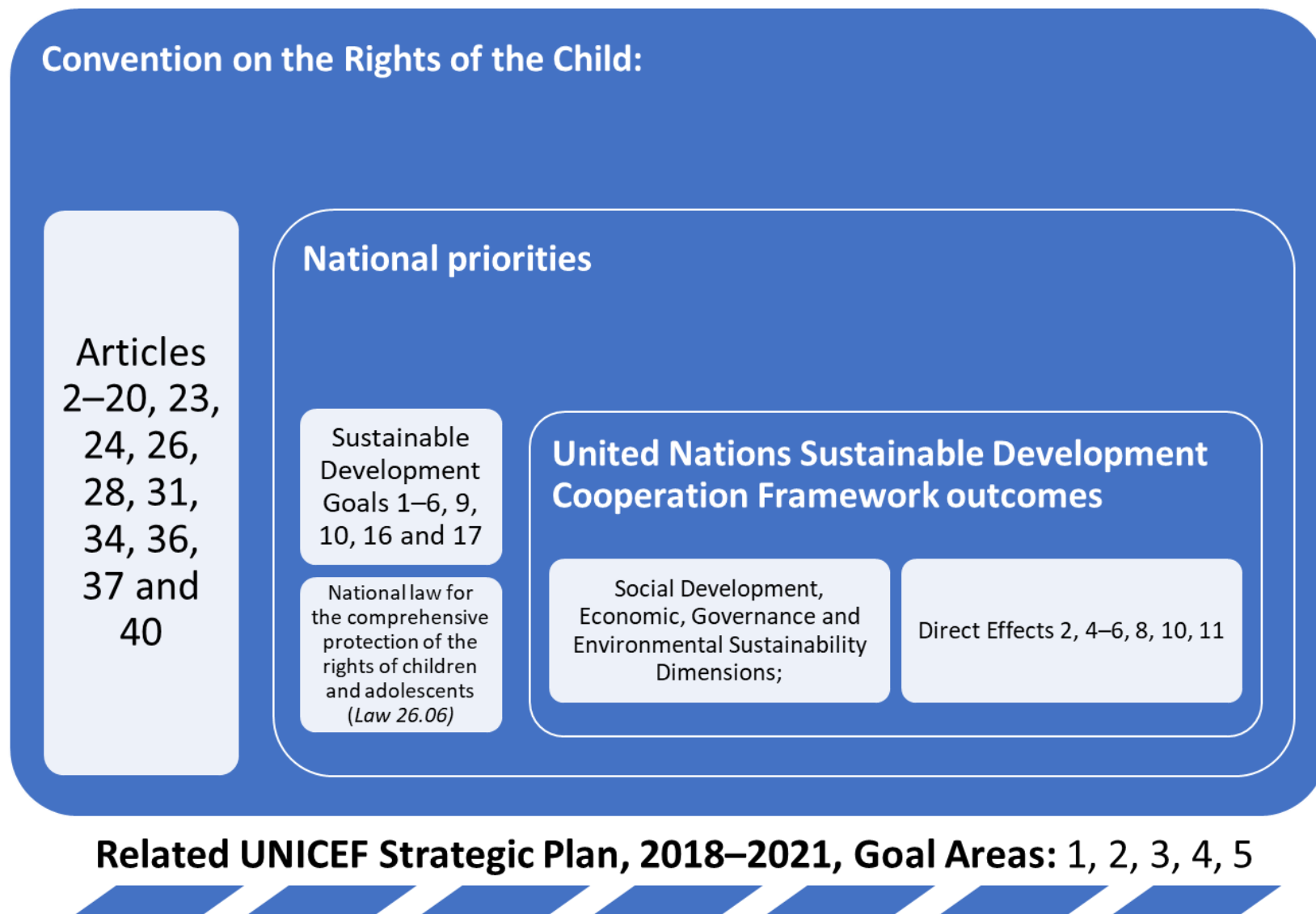
Households still use violent child-rearing methods.

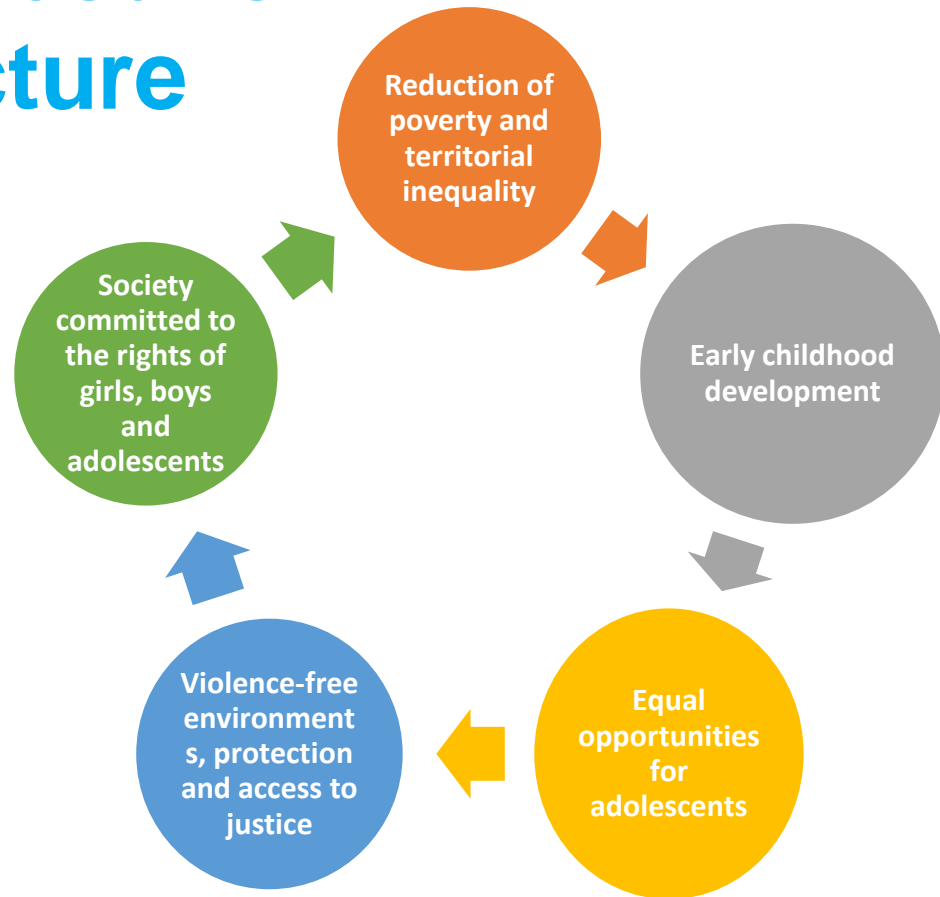
